1. PRIVACY & COOKIES POLICY

This website collects some Personal Data from its Users. The information you have provided is subject to the General Data Protection Act 2018. (The Act).

3. TYPES OF DATA COLLECTED

The Personal Data may be freely provided by the User, or collected automatically when using this website.

Any use of Cookies – or of other tracking tools – by this website or by the owners of third party services used by this website, unless stated otherwise, serves to identify Users and remember their preferences, for the sole purpose of providing the service required by the User.

Failure to provide certain Personal Data may make it impossible for this website to provide its services.

Users are responsible for any Personal Data of third parties obtained, published or shared through this website and confirm that they have the third party's consent to provide the Data to the Owner.

Your data will be used for the sole purpose of providing financial advice, administration and management.

4. DATA PROCESSING

5. METHODS OF PROCESSING

The Data Controller processes the Data of Users in a proper manner and shall take appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorised access, disclosure, modification, or unauthorised destruction of the Data.

The Data processing is carried out using computers and/or IT enabled tools, following organisational procedures and modes strictly related to the purposes indicated.
